Acting on a suggestion from our patrons Patty and Andrew, we are starting a Seed Library this fall!

We will accept donations of vegetable or flower seed, store them safely over the winter and then make them available to our gardening patrons for 'checkout' in the spring. If the crop is successful, the gardener will then 'return' some seed to the Library to begin the cycle again. There will be no overdue fines for unsuccessful crops! Saving and replanting seeds from most vegetables and many annual or perennial flowers is easy.


