The budgets are prepared on a modified accrual basis of accounting. Under the modified accrual basis of accounting, revenues are recorded when they are susceptible to accrual, i.e., both measurable and available. Expenditures are recognized in the accounting period in which the fund liability is incurred, if measurable except that principal and interest on indebtedness are not recognized as expenditures until paid. Capital assets are recorded as expenditures and depreciation is not recorded.

2015 Adopted Budget Statement

Dear Town Residents:

We are pleased to present to the 2015 Adopted Town Budget. The following summarizes the significant information in this adopted budget:

I. Total Appropriations by Fund including Transfers to Reserves

The above represents a fiscally conservative budget that funds core Town responsibilities for road maintenance, fire protection, ambulance services, local courts, planning and code enforcement while staying below the State tax cap and maintaining the Town free of general town-wide property taxes. The overall budget of \$9,765,566 exceeds projected unrestricted revenues of \$9,285,283 by \$480,283

which requires the Town to appropriate reserves for \$89,600 and to dip into the unrestricted fund balance in the amount of \$390,683 to meet the projected appropriations. Except for one added position in the Highway Department, no other new positions have been added.

II. Tax and User Rates by Fund

- General - The general town tax levy of \$8,171 funds the voter approved service award program for ambulance service volunteers at a tax rate of approximately \$.01 per thousand.
- Highway - There will be no Highway Tax for the fourteen (14th) consecutive year.
- Fire - The Town's Fire Protection levy will increase by approximately \$36,000 resulting in a tax rate of approximately \$.8283. This levy is based on a taxable assessment of \$2,292,936,223. The levy covers the cost of Volunteer Firefighter Service Award Program, fire service contracts with the Malta Ridge Volunteer Fire Department Inc., the Village of Round Lake and the Fire Companies of Malta, including the cost of the new shared fire station and fire hydrant rental.
- Library The Town's library tax levy of \$227,188 funds the voter approved proposition for the library with the balance of paid through PILOT payments. The library tax rate is approximately \$.14 per thousand.
- Sewer - The Town has two sewer districts and the users of the districts are responsible for operation and maintenance costs of these districts. Sewer user charges for 2015 will remain the same at \$165 and \$128 per equivalent dwelling unit for Sewer District #2 and Sewer District #1, respectively.

III. Appropriations/Revenues

Personnel:

A COLA of 2% plus step raises to qualified rates for some employees was applied to the salaries of Town employees. We will convert one court clerk position from part-time to full-time, provide an additional mechanic/equipment operator position in the Town Highway department and continue the use "on demand" positions for additional manpower to plow the Town's roads in the winter. The estimated total increase in salaries as a result of these items is \$108,000.

Highway:

The Town's approximate 79 lane miles of highway need regular repair and improvements. We have appropriated \$720,000 for road improvements in 2015. An appropriation of \$250,000 has been provided for the purchase of a new highway truck including plow and sander. No appropriation has been provided in 2015 for long-term highway improvements associated with the Luther Forest Planned Development District due to ongoing discussions with the representatives of the Campus.

Parks:

Continued improvements to the Town's parks and pedestrian/bicycle trail system are important quality of life issues. Therefore, we have included \$167,000 in the general outside village fund to finance future maintenance and operation to Town parkland. The budget provides the necessary funding for snow removal along the Dunning Street/Plains Road Trail and the Ice Cream Trail on a trial basis.

Bulk Waste:

A sum of \$31,000 has been budgeted to provide for the pick-up of bulk waste in the spring of 2015 in keeping with our Town practice of funding this service every other year.

Seniors:

This budget funds the following programs for the Town's seniors: Care Links - \$5,000, Malta Seniors Citizen's Inc. - \$6,200, Office for the Aging Transportation and Nutrition - \$5,600 and Malta Community Center Program Discounts - \$10,000.

Revenues:

Sales tax receipts continue to remain the largest revenue component in the Town's budget. The 2015 adopted budget assumes that the 2014 projected sales tax revenues levels will be maintained in 2015 and grow by 2% which helps the Town meet growing responsibilities. Sales tax revenues are estimated at \$4,546,000.

Fund Balance:

The Town recognizes four competing needs which must be balanced to in order to be successful:

- The Town must provide quality services to our residents
- The Town must maintain public facilities and infrastructure
- The Town must recruit, train and retain employees that meet our goal of excellent service
- The Town must maintain fiscal integrity

All four are as equally important as the other, therefore neglecting any one or placing more importance on another will negatively impact the Town's overall goals.

In order to ensure the fiscal strength of the Town in 2015 while at the same time limiting the accumulation fund balance so that service, maintenance and personnel issues can be addressed, we are proposing to maintain an amount equivalent to at least two (2) months of general operating expenditures as unreserved fund balance on an overall total fund balance basis, but also taking into account anticipated future capital improvements and repairs (ie, road infrastructure improvements). In the event of an emergency situation or due to legislative mandates that materially effects the Town's financial operations, the Town might need to reduce the unrestricted fund balance below the targeted minimum. If such should happen our goal is to replenish these amounts within the next two fiscal years.

In order to balance the Town budget and to cover appropriations that are

not considered the Town's core mission but provides benefits to Town residents, the adopted budget includes the use of \$390,000 of our "rainy day fund" (fund balance). Estimated unreserved fund balance as of December 31, 2014 is estimated to be \$2,204,000.

Additionally, we have attached to the budget report two pie charts which reflect 2015 estimated revenues and appropriations by major category.

Given the expected revenue projections, revenues are not available to support all service requests while maintaining a tax free status, therefore, we recommend that the Town continue to take corresponding measures to contain expenditures. We are pleased to adopted a budget that will be our 31st year with no general town tax aside from the voter approved \$.0050 per thousand tax rate for the service award program for the emergency services volunteers and \$.1390 per thousand tax rate for voter approved library services and a \$.8283 per thousand fire protection tax rate and no highway tax for the fourteen consecutive year. The tax rates are below the real property tax cap levy limits established by New York State. The 2015 adopted budget is below the 2014 adopted budget after the New York State Comptroller's Office calculated growth and inflation factors are applied.

This budget means that a property tax owner with a \$250,000 assessment will pay \$243 next year in real property taxes to cover the cost for fire protection, ambulance service award and library services. All other costs are paid from sales and mortgage tax receipts, court fines and a number of grants and users fees as shown in the pie chart.





SECTION 10

Town of Malta Debt Service Schedule

The Town's debt consist of \$3,400,000 in General Obligation Serial Bonds issued in September 2008 for the Community Center expansion with interest at 3.915% with a final maturity of 2028 and \$680,000 in General Obligation Serial Bonds issued January 2013 for the new Highway Garage with interest ranging from .70%-2.40% with a final maturity of 2024.

In October 2012 The Town also approved the use of \$320,000 of board designated post-employment benefit cash to finance the new highway garage and intends on replenishing it over 10 years. In 2013 and 2014 respectively the Town replenished \$82,985 and \$32,830.
