Dear Resident:

Did you know that financial help for day care is available for low income families?

The low income day care funding program is administered through Saratoga County Department of Social Services.

Here are the income eligibility guidelines:

5	\$51,580
6	\$59,060
7	\$66,540
8	\$74,020

Children up to/including 12 years of age are eligible as well as those up to/including age 18 if the child is physically/mentally incapable of caring for themselves or is under court supervision.

To inquire more about this program, ask questions regarding eligibility and services or to request an application, contact (518) 714-4004. An application will be mailed to you and the process may be done entirely by mail or you may request a face-to-face interview appointment with an eligibility worker.

I urge income eligible families in Malta to take advantage of available financial aid.
