Route 9 from Kendall Way to just north of Avenue of the Pines
Town of Malta and City of Saratoga Springs, Saratoga County
NYSDOT Contract D264406

Dear Supervisor O'Connor/Mayor Kelly:

We are pleased to advise you that work on the above-referenced project is scheduled to start on Tuesday, September 7.

The work will consist of the following:

- upgrades to ADA sidewalk ramps at Route 9's intersections with South Landon Lane, Ellsworth Boulevard, Old Post Road, Crescent Avenue and the Avenue of the Pines
- pavement repairs as needed
- 1" mill and fill pavings from Kendall Way to Cramer Road and from Crescent Avenue to the Avenue of the Pines
- a 1/2" shim plus 1" overlay paving from Cramer Road to Crescent Avenue
- a 1" mill and fill paving on the bridge over I-87 at Exit 13
- driveway and side road tie-ins and shoulder backup as needed

Work will progress weekdays between 6 AM and 5 PM; the road will remain open at all times, with single lane closures used to provide safe work areas; flagpersons will control traffic at the intersections near the work areas. The contractor will be required to remove all lane closures by 3:30 PM on dates when there are events scheduled at the Saratoga Performing Arts Center.

We currently expect that the work will be completed by October 29, subject to weather and other conditions encountered in the field. We will advise you and the CC list if the pace of progress necessitates a significant change to the expected completion date.
